

Good morning everyone

This week I am pleased to share with you the announcement that the Foundation Principal of Catherine McAuley College, our new secondary school in South Mackay, is Jim Ford. As many of you would be aware Jim is currently the Principal of Mercy College, Mackay, a role he has held for the past 15 years. Jim commences his new role from the beginning of the 2021 school year as extensive planning and preparation gets underway in readiness to welcome students and families in 2022. Those in our Mackay region may have noticed building works are now well advanced and in response to recent advertising we are already taking enrolment enquiries for 2022 and well beyond. I wish to acknowledge and thank two of our Regional Board Liaison Officers, who will be finishing in their roles at the end of this year for their dedicated service to each of their communities. Caryll Schofield has provided strong and enthusiastic support to Boards at St Patrick's College and Emmanuel Catholic Primary School in Mackay, and Lyn McGuire's many years of wise counsel for Boards at Marist College, St Patrick's and St Brigid's Catholic Primary Schools, Emerald will be sorely missed.
